## COMPETITION DETAILS

### Competition & Team Registration

- Entry is open to all current and aspiring Big V entrants across all divisions.
- Victorian Youth Championship teams are eligible to enter, however please note this weekend will also be the opening Round for the 2017 season.
- SEABL Teams are eligible to enter the State Championship division
- Other teams are welcome to enter, however, final acceptance into the tournament will be at Big V's discretion
- Minimum of 3 games guaranteed for every team
- Tournament Rules detailed on page 4
- Any issues that arise which are not provided for in the tournament manual, will be covered within the Big V By-laws
- All results are uploaded online instantly using 'Stadium Scoring'
- All team registration fees must to be paid in full at time entry is submitted
- Once your team is registered and your payment has been successfully processed, we will provide you with your Entrant Confirmation & Welcome Pack.
- All communications regarding the tournament will be distributed to club representatives nominated on team registration forms via email prior to the event and phone (voice call / SMS) during the event.

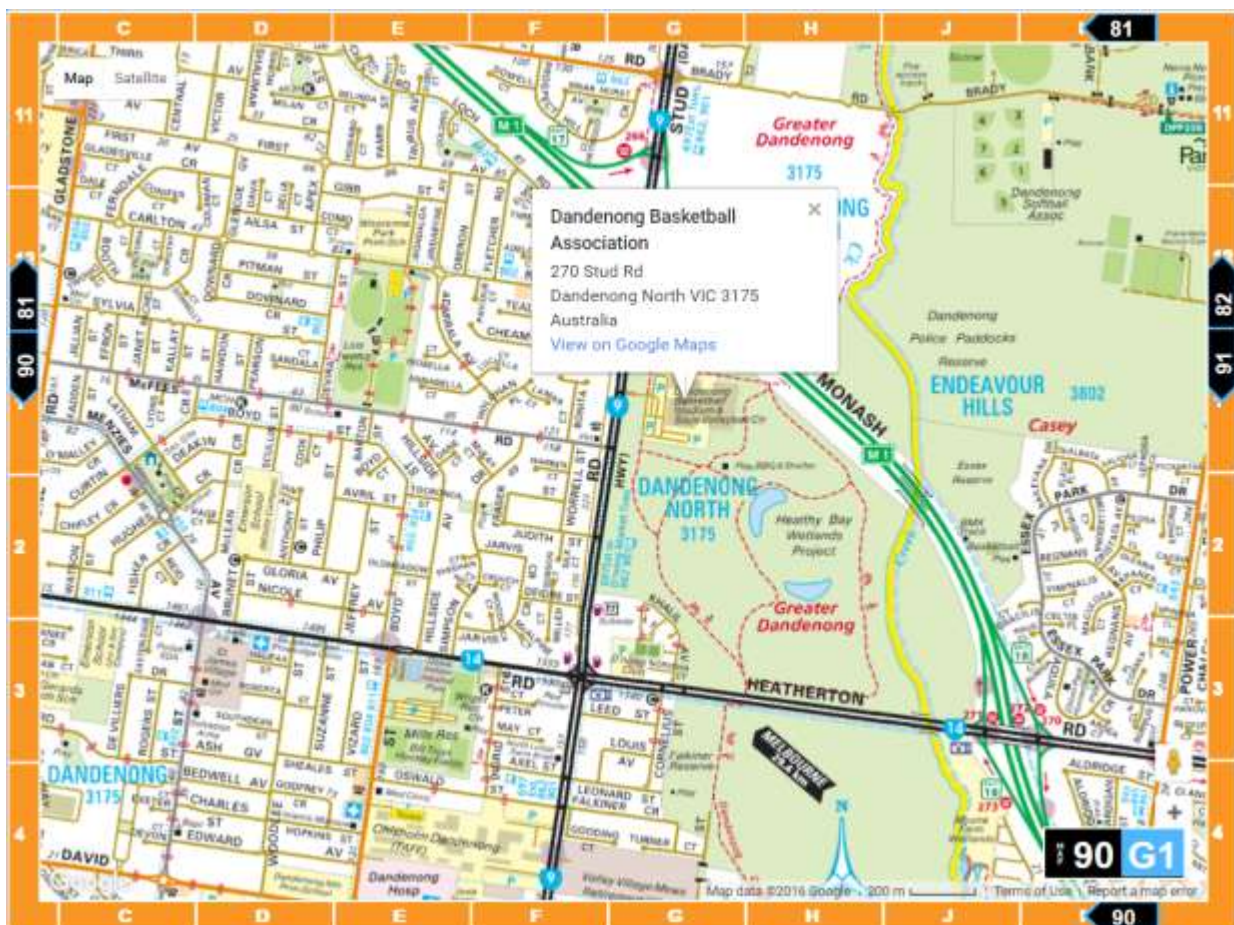

# BIG V PRE SEASON TOURNAMENT

## TOURNAMENT RULES

### Starting the Game

- Team managers to ensure all players and playing numbers are correct on the Stadium Scoring computers before the commencement of first scheduled game
- Teams are asked to ensure that all players are correctly uniformed
- The first team listed on the fixture will be expected to change in the event of a colour clash
- A spare set of singlets will be held at the reception desk in the event of an emergency
- No team may commence a game with fewer than five players
- There is a two point penalty for each minute late. Failure to appear within ten minutes of the scheduled game time means a forfeit: score 20-0.

### Playing Rules

- ALL games will use an official Molten basketball to be supplied by participating teams
- A size 6 ball will be used for the women and a size 7 ball will be used for men's matches
- The usual premierships points apply: three points for a win, two for a draw, one for a loss and none for a forfeit
- Finals are determined based on the percentage of games won, to games played (PP%)

### Timing Rules for all matches

- Five minutes warm-up time is allowed prior to the start of the each match
- Matches consist of four ten (10) minute quarters
- 2 minute allocated for 1/4 & 3/4 time
- Five minutes is allocated for Half Time
- Players should be ready to start the second half immediately the half-time interval is concluded
- Games will not be delayed because players are not on court
- Teams are allowed one time-out per quarter, except the last, which will have two time-outs
- The clock shall stop on all time outs; and on all whistles in last minute of second quarter and last 3 minutes of 4th quarter
- 24 SECOND SHOT CLOCK in operation for tournament
- Draws are allowed, except in semi-finals and grand-finals. In the case of a draw in finals, extra time will be played. Each extra-period will be five minutes

### Prize Money

- The winning teams of each division will win the allocated prize money for their division, for which a cheque will be issued to the club contact person during the week after the tournament.
- Winning teams will be presented with a novelty cheque during the presentation ceremony
- Prize money amount is subject to minimum number of teams entered

## 2017 BIG V PRE-SEASON EVENT FAQ's

### Car Parking

Car parking at Dandenong Stadium is FREE!

Please allow extra time for parking, it will be busy. No games will be delayed for players who are running late due to parking issues.

### Entry into the Tournament – CASH PREFERRED

VYC – Only players & team officials as advised during the week prior to Round 1 will be admitted FREE of charge. Free entry applies only for the game they are playing in. Please note that if VYC players are attending to watch the tournament, will be required to pay the entry fee.

Everyone must pay the prescribed entry fee as outlined on previous page. This includes players, parents, spectators, assistant coaches and team managers.

If you are an official working over the weekend, you will be given an official pass. All patrons MUST observe the Basketball Victoria Terms and Conditions of entry.

There will be different coloured passes for each day. **No valid pass = No Entry**

Cash is preferred however we do have EFTPOS facilities available should you require to pay with a card.

### Do Coaches and Team Managers have to pay to get into the Tournament?

1x FREE HEAD COACH pass will be available for collection at your first game. All other team officials must pay the entry fee as stated on previous page.

### Late Payments and Entry Forms

There are NO refunds for ANY team that has withdrawn.

All monies owing are to be paid when submitting your registration and you will not be able to submit your entry without including payment details.

### How do the finals work across the Tournament?

1v2 Finals format at the end of the rounds for each division.

### Classification of Teams and Determination of Rankings for Finals:

The primary ranking of teams shall be based on Game Ratio, and then based Points according to their win – loss records (3 Points for a win, 2 Points for a draw, 1 point for a loss, 0 points for a game lost by forfeit)

Before proceeding to the below, if all teams that are equal on 'Game Ratio' then 'Points', have not played each other, then the ranking will go straight to 'Point Difference' taking into account the results of all games

If there are two teams equal, the result(s) of the game(s) between the two teams involved will be used to determine the placing. (Head to Head) In the event that this does not split the two teams, the classification will be determined by Points Difference taking into account the results of all games played by both teams.

If more than two teams are equal, a classification will be established taking into account only the results of the games between the teams that are tied.

In the event that there are still teams tied after the second classification, then points difference will be used to determine the placing, taking into account only the results between the teams that are tied.

If there are still teams tied, the placing shall be determined using percentage from the results of all their games played

Points difference is calculated by points scored for, minus points scored against.

# BIG V PRE SEASON TOURNAMENT

Where teams have played an uneven amount of games and have the same points, team ranking will be based on percentage of games won to games played.

## What happens if there is a uniform clash?

The first team listed on the fixture will be expected to change; The list of uniform colours are in a separate attached document; and a spare set of singlets will be held in the Tournament Office in case of emergency

## Results

Available via SportingPulse / FIBA Organiser and coordinated by Dandenong Basketball Association's Competitions Manager. Support will be provided by the DBA administration staff as required.

Results cannot be calculated until AFTER the LAST match of the Pool has been played. Please be patient, as soon as they have calculated final positions, one of them will contact your Team Manager.
